

Animal Feeding, Housing and Care Cost Formula
At the AdvS North Logan Research Farm

1. Facility Use: \$1.50 per day, per unit.
(Unit can be an area, corral or pasture)

2. Special Facilities (buildings)
 - a. Surgery Room: \$12.50 use fee, plus \$7.50 cleaning fee per cleaning
 - b. Enclosed building: \$1.50 per day
 - c. Enclosed building with heat and/or air conditioning: additional cost will reflect actual use when heat or air conditioning is in use.
 - d. Pavilion: \$15.00 per use, plus \$7.50 per hour prep fee
(Every attempt will be made to keep charges for facility use as close to actual cost as possible. If cleaning before and after use is required, P.I./Project leader may choose to furnish their own personnel or pay the North Logan Farm (NLF) to do the work.)

3. Specialized Equipment - Negotiated with farm manager
 - a. Truck
 - b. Truck with rack
 - c. Loader tractor
 - d. Trailer
 - e. Other
(Use of any equipment will need to be arranged. Fees or charges for the equipment use will be determined before any equipment is used, preferably when the request form for facility use is signed.)

4. Cleaning of a Unit
 - a. P.I./Project leader furnishes help to assist NLF personnel - \$12.50/unit.
 - b. NLF personnel entirely - \$12.50/unit plus \$7.50/hr.
 - c. P.I. furnishes qualified equipment operator - \$10.00/unit plus cost of fuel, equipment and facility repairs if damaged, etc.
 - d. P.I. cleans and uses own equipment and personnel - No charge
(If P.I. chooses to clean and maintain a unit, the unit must be left in a condition satisfactory to the Farm Manager when project ends.)

5. Feeding and Bedding
 - a. P.I./Project leader may handle buying, hauling and stacking of feed and bedding - no charge.
 - b. P.I./Project leader takes all responsibility of feeding and bedding of animals - no charge.
 - c. Purchase of feed and bedding, hauling and stacking by NLF personnel when

possible - cost plus \$7.50/hr. per person.

- d. Animals fed entirely or part time by NLF personnel: \$7.50/hr.
- e. Bedding placed in pen by NLF personnel: \$7.50/hr.
(Includes time to haul, mix, chop, etc.)
- f. Pasture utilization - Cost will be determined by Farm Manager, Dept. Head, AES and P.I.
(Pasture use will continue to give preference to studies that require pasture grazing, AES animals, project animals and private animals, in that order.
Charges will be based on established UAES formula for AUM's for pasture use.)

6. Animal Handling

All transportation, weighing, vaccinating, castrating, lambing, calving or basic record keeping, etc. will be done at actual cost plus \$7.50 per person/hour.

7. Methods of Billing

- a. Billing for units used and services performed will be done quarterly.
- b. Billing for entire project may be done at the time the project is started, adjustments will be made at the end of the project.

8. Charges for all non-ADVS, non-UAES projects will be doubled.

P.I.'s will have the option to reduce labor costs by furnishing all labor and equipment to feed, clean pens and bed pens. This also includes animal handling, vaccinating, weighing, blood collection, etc. Labor must be qualified to do the required job as certified by the F.M. If P.I. uses own help, the activities or use of NLF equipment must be coordinated with the F.M. The charges for unit use or specialized facility use will still be in effect.
